Chromatic on E (2 octaves)

Jazz melodic minor (2 octaves)

Arpeggios

G major (2 octaves)

G minor (2 octaves)

Chords

G and D Min 7ths (Different Shapes)

Dominant 7th in C (G7)

G Major 7ths
