Special or different learning needs (SEND)

Any application for a necessary adjustment you may need to access one of our qualifications falls under our 'Reasonable Adjustments' policy and will be dealt with on a case-by-case basis. You will be asked to provide the following information:

- Learner's name, instrument and grade
- MTB Exams reference number (only if the exam has already been entered)
- The nature of, and rationale for, the request
- Any supporting information/evidence (eg medical evidence or a statement from the
 - teacher or any other appropriate information)

Once we receive your application for a Reasonable Adjustment, we aim to respond to you with a decision within 10 working days.
